

# 93<sup>rd</sup> Davis Invite - Meet Information

**Saturday, April 7, 2018 – Zaepfel Stadium, Yakima WA**

**Entry Fee:** There is a **\$150.00 Team Entry Fee** for this meet. Checks should be made out to **Davis ASB** and mailed to:

**Start Time:** The meet will start promptly at **10:00 am**.

**Coaches Meeting:** 9:30 am on the infield near the finish line.

**Events:** See the Event Schedule for a complete list for Frosh-Soph Girls and Boys, and Varsity Boys and Girls events and start times. An individual that competes in the Frosh-Soph section of the meet will be ineligible to compete in the Varsity sections of the meet. **Please limit entries to two athletes per running event and one team per relay.**

**Entry Sheets:** Each team's event roster will be printed out and placed in the team packets, and a full meet schedule posted on the red board on the South wall of the Timing Booth/Shed. **Registration closes on *Athletic.net* at 5:00 pm Friday, April 6<sup>th</sup>.** Any athlete with a bib who wants to enter an event after 5:00 pm Friday, must acquire a bib at the finish line Timing Booth and then check-in with the Course Clerk or Field Event Clerk, at or before the first call for the event, and request their name and bib number be penciled in for a flight/heat (at the discretion of the Course Clerk or Field Event Clerk.) NOTE: The only changes made at the Timing Booth should be the resolution of data or registration errors, and the issuing of bib numbers to unregistered athletes (not entered in any event), from registered teams. **(No need to submit 'drops')**

**Running Events:** All running event results will be based on heat performances, without event finals. Heats will be seeded slowest to fastest, allowing for the addition of competitors to the earlier heats, at the discretion of the Course Clerk. All running event athletes must wear their assigned number on the front of their uniform during the meet.

**Field Events:** At the scheduled event time, check in with the Event Clerk at the site of event. The Shot-put, Javelin and Discus are located on the field at the South side of the Stadium. Athletes will complete all their attempts in rotation before a new flight begins. There will be 3 attempts in all the jumping and throwing events. **There will be finals in all Varsity throwing and horizontal jumping events, with the top 9 athletes advancing for 3 additional throws or jumps.** For throwing and horizontal jump events, preliminary flights will be seeded shortest to the longest seed mark, with the addition of competitors to flights at the discretion of the Event Clerk, and with the finals flight seeded shortest qualifying preliminary jump or throw to the longest. Vertical jumping events will be seeded lowest to highest seed mark. All field event athletes must wear their assigned number on the front of their uniform during the meet. (Pole-vaulters may wear their number on the back, while competing in the Pole Vault). Jumpers are advised to set their marks before the event begins, and will be allowed one run-through..

**Vertical Jumping Events:** Minimum starting heights will be in effect for the High Jump, and Pole Vault:

Frosh-Soph Girls' High Jump	4'-0"		
Varsity Girls' High Jump	4'-4"	Pole Vault	6'-0"
Frosh-Soph Boys' High Jump	4'-6"		
Varsity Boys' High Jump	5'-0"	Pole Vault	8'-0"

**Awards:** There will be Medals for the winners in all events. Places 2nd-8th will receive Ribbons. Additionally, there will be 'Traveling' Trophies for the following events:

Boys' 100m Dash – Willie Turner Award  
Boys' 4 x 400m Relay – John Kranz Memorial  
Boys' 600m, 200m, 400m, 800m Sprint Medley Relay – Foster Memorial

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**Timing:** Fully Automatic Timing (FAT) will be in use for all running events.

**Warm-Ups and Spike Lengths:** Please keep the infield clear for warm-ups only. On the track, warm-ups will be limited to on the North side, outside the 'blue-line' on lane 6. **ALL SPIKES are preferred to be no longer than 3/16"** (or 1/4" at the absolute longest). We will be checking for spike length in all events (including the javelin).

**Results:** Results will be posted on *Athletic.net* immediately after the meet concludes.

**Admission:** All competing athletes (dressed in school warm-ups) and coaches will be admitted free to the meet. Teams must enter by the Southwest Gate. Admission will be charged for all spectators:

Adults . . . . . \$3.00

Students (w/I.D.), Military, and Senior Citizens (65+) . . . \$2.00

**Parking/Tents:** Please park busses at the South West Parking Lot, or at the adjacent Wilson Middle School. The North Side Parking Lot (on Tieton Dr.) is reserved for spectator parking. **There is only a small amount of flat field areas available for team tents. Team tents are also allowed in the North or South bleachers of Zaepfel Stadium.**

**T-Shirts:** Custom designed shirts will be on sale.

**Concessions:** A concession stand will be open for business for the duration of the meet.
